Dr. Jena possesses over 30 years of research experience in different fields of freshwater aquaculture and conservation genetics, and has been holding the position of Deputy Director General (Fisheries Science) at ICAR since January

2016. As the DDG (Animal Science), he steered the programmes of the Animal Science Division of ICAR for about three years, i.e. from April 2017-January 2020. Before that, he has served as the Director of the ICAR-National Bureau of Fish Genetic Resources (NBFGR), Lucknow for over 5 years.

Working in different aspects of freshwater aquaculture at the ICAR-Central Institute of Freshwater Aquaculture (CIFA), Bhubaneswar during his initial career in different capacities, viz., National Fellow and Head of the Division, he has contributed to the development of several technologies and research findings, including aquaculture diversification; intensive carp culture; treatment of domestic sewage through aquaculture; cryopreservation and applied nutrition. Operated over 20 research projects, including 10 externally-funded projects as Principal Investigator. As National Coordinator, in addition to that of Consortium Research Platform on Genomics since 2015 with 12 ICAR institutes, he has been operating the National Surveillance Programme for Aquatic Animal Diseases (NSPAAD) in India with the involvement of 27 partner organizations for the last 7 years. Further, as National Coordinator, executing the Indian Network on Fisheries and Animal Antimicrobial Resistance (INFAAR), initiated by ICAR with the involvement of 22 Animal Science and Fisheries Research institutes. He has published over 300 research papers in national and international journals of repute, besides several books and other publications.
