Annual Review Meeting of "AINP-AMR in Fisheries and Livestock"

The Annual Review Meeting of the "All India Network Project on Antimicrobial Resistance (AINP-AMR) in Fisheries and Livestock" under INFAAR was held at the NASC Complex, New Delhi, on August 20–21, 2025. The inaugural session of the review meeting was chaired by Dr. Mangi Lal Jat, Hon'ble Secretary (DARE) & Director General (ICAR), in the presence of Dr. J. K. Jena, Deputy Director General (Fisheries Science); Dr. Raghvendra Bhatta, Deputy Director General (Animal Science) and Dr. Kajal Chakraborty, Director, ICAR-NBFGR, Lucknow. Dr. Jat commended the project as a successful model of collaboration between animal and fisheries sciences, stressing the need for effective data utilization to advance both sectors. He further suggested for evaluating AMR profile between commercial and integrated farming systems. The event is being attended by officers from the Animal Science and Fisheries Divisions of ICAR, representatives from FAO India, and Principal Investigators and Co-Principal Investigators of the network project of 31 partners. In the two-day meeting the AMR data generated by network partners during 2024-25 have been reviewed and discussed.
