ICAR-National Bureau of Fish Genetic Resources, Lucknow is a premier fisheries research institute under the Department of Agricultural Research and Education, Indian Council of Agricultural Research, Government of India, which is engaged in research on enhancing fish production in the country and conservation of fish species in natural habitats through exploration, cataloguing, evaluation and characterization of Indian fish species.
